

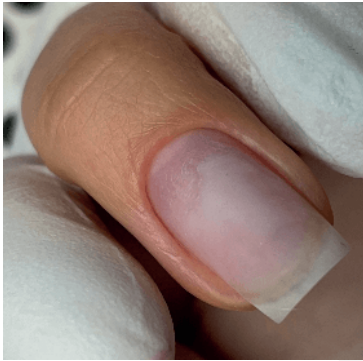


APPLICATION GUIDE

UV Gel Nail Polish | UV Builder Gel

Prepare Nails For UV Gel Nail Process

(This steps **ALWAYS NEEDS TO BE DONE** before applying UV Gel Nail Polish and before applying UV Hard Gel)



STEP 1: Cut and Shape Nails

- Use nail clippers to trim your nails to the desired length.
- Use a Semilac "Straight" 100/180 Nail File to shape them. Choose between square, oval, almond, or any shape you prefer.



STEP 2: Soften Cuticles

- Apply a small amount of Semilac Cuticle Remover around the base of each nail. Wait for a few minutes to let it soften the cuticles.



STEP 3: Push Back Cuticles

- Use a Semilac Cuticle Pusher or Semilac Wooden Sticks to gently push back the cuticles. Be very gentle to avoid damaging the nail bed.

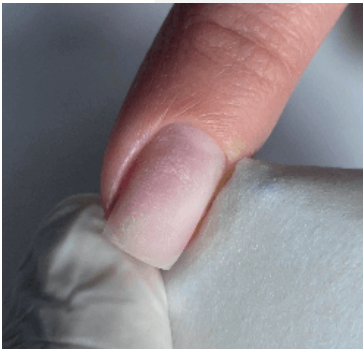
Prepare Nails For UV Gel Nail Process

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STEP 4: Cut Excess Cuticles

- Gently clip away any excess or loose cuticle using a Semilac Cuticle Nippers. Be cautious and do not cut too close to the nail bed.

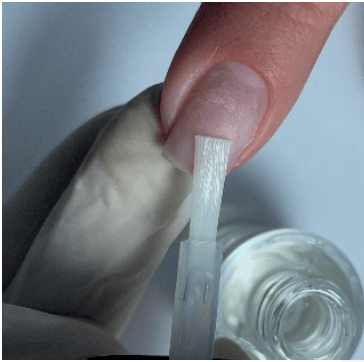


STEP 5: Buff and Clean The Nails

- Use a Semilac Sanding Block File/Buffer to gently smooth the surface of your nails. This helps the gel adhere better.
- Use a Semilac Cotton Pads Dust Free soaked in Semilac Nail Cleaner to wipe off any dust or debris from your nails.

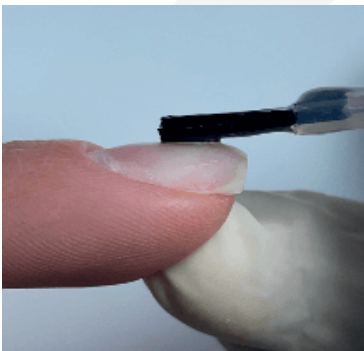
Application UV Gel Nail Polish

(ALWAYS REMEMBER TO PREPARE the nail plate before applying UV Gel Nail Polish)



STEP 1: Apply Primer

- Apply a thin layer of Semilac Primer to each nail. This helps the UV gel nail polish adhere better and prevents lifting.



STEP 2: Apply Base Coat

- Apply a thin layer of Semilac Base Coat UV Gel Polish. This provides a smooth surface for the UV gel nail polish and helps with adhesion.



STEP 3: Apply the UV Gel Nail Polish

- Apply a thin, even layer of Semilac UV gel nail polish to each nail. Avoid getting polish on your skin or cuticles.
- Cure under the Semilac UV or LED nail lamp according to the manufacturer's instructions.

Application UV Gel Nail Polish

(ALWAYS REMEMBER TO PREPARE the nail plate before applying UV Gel Nail Polish)



STEP 6: Cleanse and Finish

- Use a Semilac Cotton Pads Dust Free and Semilac Nail Cleanser to remove any sticky residue left on the nails. (If you are using Semilac No Wipe Top you can skip this step.)
- Apply Semilac Moisturising Nail and Cuticle Oil or a moisturizing cream to keep your nails and cuticles healthy.



STEP 4: Apply Additional Layers

- Apply a second coat of Semilac UV gel nail polish to each nail.
- Cure second layer under the Semilac UV or LED nail lamp according to the manufacturer's instructions.



STEP 5: Apply Top Coat

- For extra shine and protection, apply a thin layer of Semilac Top Coat UV Gel Polish. (If you want matt nails - use Semilac Top Mat Total No Wipe UV Gel Polish)
- Cure top under the Semilac UV or LED lamp according to the manufacturer's instructions.

UV Gel Nail Polish Removal



STEP 1: File the Top Coat

- Use a Semilac “Straight” 100/180 Nail File to gently remove the shiny top coat of the UV gel nail polish. This helps the remover penetrate the layers more effectively.



STEP 2: Apply Cotton Pads

- Place a soaked Semilac Cotton Pads Dust Free on top of each nail.
- Wrap the cotton-covered nail with a piece of aluminum foil, securing it in place.
- Allow the foil wraps to stay in place for about 10-15 minutes. This gives the remover time to dissolve the UV gel nail polish.



STEP 3: Gently Remove the UV Gel Nail Polish

- After soaking, apply slight pressure to the nail through the foil wrap and use a gentle twisting motion to help remove the softened UV gel nail polish.
- Use a Semilac Cuticle Pusher or Semilac Wooden Sticks to gently scrape off any remaining polish. Be careful not to scrape too hard, as this can damage the nail.
- Repeat step if necessary.

Nail Extension Using Semilac UV Builder Gel

(ALWAYS REMEMBER to prepare your nail plate for nail extensions following the instructions from the first page of this document)



STEP 1: Apply Nail Forms

- Apply the nail forms under your natural nails. Ensure they are secure and properly aligned with the shape and length you want to achieve.



STEP 2: Apply Primer

- Apply a thin layer of Semilac Primer to each nail. This helps with adhesion and prevents lifting.



STEP 3: Apply Extend Base Coat

- Apply a thin layer of Semilac Extend Base Coat UV Gel Polish to your nails. This provides a smooth surface for the extension and helps with adhesion.
- Cure Semilac Extend Base Coat UV Gel Polish under Semilac UV or Led lamp according to the anufacturer's instructions.

Nail Extension Using Semilac UV Builder Gel

(ALWAYS REMEMBER to prepare your nail plate for nail extensions following the instructions from the first page of this document)



STEP 4: Create the Extension

- Using a Semilac Gel Brush Basic Gel Flat, apply a thin layer of Semilac Builder UV Gel onto the nail forms. Sculpt the gel to create the desired shape and length for your extensions.
- Place your nails under a Semilac UV or LED lamp and cure according to the instructions provided with your Semilac products. This will harden and set the gel.



STEP 5: Remove Nail Forms

- Gently remove the nail forms. You should be left with the extended nail shape you created.



STEP 6: File and Shape

- Use a Semilac Cotton Pads Dust Free and Semilac Nail Cleanser to remove any sticky residue left on the nails.
- Using a Semilac "Straight" 100/180 Nail File, shape and smooth the extensions to your desired length and style. Use a buffer to refine the surface.
